



GRIFFITHS SCALES OF CHILD DEVELOPMENT (GRIFFITHS III) Practical Training Course

1st - 3rd APRIL 2025

The Griffiths Scales of Child Development -3^{rd} Edition (Griffiths III) is a child friendly standardised developmental assessment which assesses 5 main areas of childhood development. It can be administered to children 0-6 years.

To become a user of the Griffiths III, you are required to compete the following steps:

- 1. Complete the Griffiths Video Training Course (a separate cost to the Practical Training)
- 2. Attend and complete a Griffiths III Practical Training Course

A Practical Training Course will be run by the **Child Development Team**. The course will consist of demonstrations as well as opportunities for supervised practice in the administration of the scales to typically developing children. There will be tutorials regarding testing children with developmental differences and reporting results.

Those who successfully complete both the Video Learning and the Practical Training will obtain a certificate and be registered as an accredited Griffiths III user by The Association for Research in Infant and Child Development (ARICD).
